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TYLENOL* SHOULD CONTROL ANY MINOR DISCOMFORT

It is important to avoid any Non-Steroidal Anti-Inflammatories (NSAIDs) such as Advil or Aleve for 4 weeks after the treatment. NSAIDs have been shown to inhibit orthodontic movements.^{<1>}
